There is no make-up date in case of weather conditions.• Entry Fee refunds will be provided if the meet does not start due to inclement weather.• Program and Admission will not be refunded if the meet is called due to weather.• Partial entry refunds will be given if at least the first five events are not swum.• No scratches will be refunded if the meet is called off, once started.

Facility Info	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The DiDomenico Municipal Pool is a 50 meter, 8-lane pool with 7' lanes using anti-splash lane dividers, and Colorado timing. The depth at the starting end is 9' and the depth at the turn end is 4'• Spectators must bring their own seats—beach chairs, folding chairs etc. The facility does not have spectator seating.
Pool Certification Statement	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Note that this statement is a required meet announcement statement, and refers to the pre-certification of the pool length measurement in regards to National and World Record swims which may occur in the pool. The fact that this pool is not certified in accordance to 104.2.2C(4) does not impact on the validity of the times achieved in this pool. Times swum at this meet will in fact be entered in SWIMS and are eligible for qualifying for any other USA Swimming sanctioned competition.

<p>Entries / Entry Information & Deadline</p>	<p>Entries must be received by Friday, June 8th, 2016</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries as an attached file to an e-mail. • Email entry files to besmarttinc@gmail.com • The meet entry coordinator will respond to e-mail entries within 48 hours. If you do not receive an e-mail response within 48 hours, assume that your email has not been received. It then becomes the e-mailer's responsibility to make sure that the host club's meet entry coordinator receives the e-mail. <p>Entry Times</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NJ Swimming does not allow NT or 'No Time' entries. NT's will not be accepted. • All entry times must be in long course meters. • Converted times from SCY and SCM are acceptable for this meet. • There are no time standards for this meet.
<p>Entry Fees</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual Event Entry Fee: \$5.00 • See the above "Date of Meet" section of the announcement for the refund policy.
<p>Meet Age</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will have 12 & Under and Open events. • Age for this meet is as of: Friday, June 17th, 2016
<p>Swimmer Eligibility</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All swimmers must be members of USA Swimming and must be listed on a team's official entry form to be eligible to participate in this swim meet in any events. • All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers are to use a UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. • All unattached swimmers must be listed on the team's official waiver entry form. • New Jersey Swimming allows swimmers to swim up to three (3) individual events per day.
<p>Meet Format Waiver</p>	<p>The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the sanctioning chairman and either the age group or senior chairman. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet management has the right to restrict the number of entries due to darkness, and to conform to the New Jersey Swimming 4-hour session rule. • Session duration will be planned for approximately 3 hours.

<p>Meet Requirement Statement</p>	<p>In order to be eligible for the New Jersey Swimming Zone Championship Team or for NJ Swimming Athlete Travel Grants for sectional and national level meets, NJ Swimming policy stipulates certain participation requirements. As a NJ Swimming sanctioned meet, this meet counts towards those participation requirements.</p>



Coaches Eligibility	All coaches “on the deck” must be current coach members of USA Swimming. Coaches must have coaching card visible at all times while on deck and to gain admittance to the facility.
USA-S Racing Start Certification Statement	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
USA-S Deck Change Policy Statement	Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.
Meet Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will be run in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules. • This meet will be run as a timed final meet. • There are no time standards for this meet. • This meet will be deck seeded with coaches checking in/scratching all swimmers. When the seeding has been posted, swimmers will report to the blocks on their own.
Meet Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The facility will open at 4:45 pm. Warm-up will start at 5:00 pm and the meet will start at 5:55pm. • The meet will have one session.

Admission and Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admission will be \$5.00 and Heat Sheets will be \$5.00.
Warm-up Procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. • All swimmers are entitled to a fair and comparable warm-up. All teams will get the same opportunity for warm-up lanes. • All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool. • Scarlet Aquatics Meet Marshalls will monitor warm-ups. • All general warm-up lanes will swim in a counterclockwise direction. • Warm-up will be split into two 25 minute sessions with assigned lanes and warm-up periods for participating teams. • Teams may do one way, dive sprints during their assigned warm-up period. Teams sharing a lane must wait for all teams in the lane to complete general warm-up before using the lane for dive sprints.
Check-In	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All swimmers will be checked-in by their coaches. Those not checked in will be scratched. • All check-in sheets must be turned into the scoring table 30 minutes before the start of the session. Swimmers that are swimming will have a line through their name. Swimmers that are being scratched will have their names circled with a “SCR” next to the circle. Swimmers scratching a single event will have a line through his/her name and the event circled with “SCR” next to the circle. • Failure to follow this procedure may result in the swimmer(s) being scratched from the entire session.
Starts	‘Fly-over’/‘Over-the-top’ starts will be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medals will be awarded to the top three swimmers in each event. • In the 12 & Under events, medals will be awarded to the top three 10 & Under swimmers and the top three 11-12 swimmers. • In the Open events, medals will be awarded to the top three swimmers, regardless of age.
Scoring	Team Scoring will not be kept.



Host Club Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The host club will provide a single timer in each lane throughout the meet. • The host club will have stopwatches available for volunteers helping to time. • The host club will e-mail all club entries back to the participating clubs. • The host club will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. This warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to all participating clubs one week before the meet. • The host club will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. These timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs one week before the meet.
Participating Club Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs one week prior to the meet and posted on the Be Smartt web site. • Participating club parents must stay within designated areas away from the pool edges except for timing assignments. • Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible.
Concessions	Food and drink will be available.
Vendor	Ultimate Swim Shop will be on site as the swim equipment vendor for the meet.
Directions	<p>Directions to Bayonne DiDomenico Pool Address: 157 W 16th Street, Bayonne NJ, 07002</p> <p>From NJ Turnpike Take Exit 14 (Bayonne) and proceed along Avenue E to East 16th Street. Turn right and continue for 4 blocks. The pool is on the right, across from the firehouse and children's park. Continue past the pool for ample parking available at 16th Street Park, at the end of West 16th Street.</p>

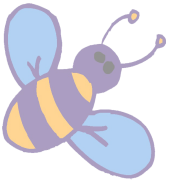
